HSCA By-Laws

Membership Criteria

Please select the box that applies to you. NOTE: 5.04(c) is a mandatory field.

5.04 Regular Members

Upon payment of the prescribed membership fees, and upon approval of the Board of Directors in accordance with the following, the following are eligible to be admitted as members:

- a) an individual who is eighteen (18) years of age or over and resides, works or carries on business in the area served by the Society, and is not employed by the Society, or
- b) a corporation which has its head office or carries on business in the area served by the Society; and
- c) supports the mission and goals of the Society.

5.05 Termination of Regular Membership

A regular membership in the Society is not transferable and automatically terminates:

- (a) if the member resigns as a member of the Society or dies; or
- (b) if the member no longer meets the criteria set out in section 5.04 "Regular Members" of this by-law; or
- (c) if the member fails to pay the prescribed membership dues for the next membership year at or before the annual meeting; or
- (d) any person who has been convicted of a criminal offence punishable by indictment shall immediately advise the Society and shall immediately cease to become a member after such conviction and shall not be eligible to continue to be a member of the Society.

5.08 Removal of Members

The Board of Directors of the Society shall have the authority to suspend or expel any member from the Society for any one or more of the following grounds:

- (a) violating any provisions of the Articles, By-laws or written policies of the Society;
- (b) carrying out any conduct which may be detrimental to the Society or contrary to the missions and goals of the Society as determined by the Board in its sole discretion;
- (c) for any other reason that the Board, in its sole and absolute discretion, considers to be reasonable, having regard to the purpose of the Society.
