The Four Stages of Child Restraint Use



Stage One: Rear-Facing Infant Seat

- \cdot 0 10 kg (22 lb.)
- Birth to approximately 1 year old



Stage Two: Forward-Facing Child Seat

- 10 18 kg (22 40 lb.)
- Approximately 1 to 4 ½ years old



Stage Three: Booster Seat

- 18 36 kg (40 80 lb.)
- Approximately 4 ½ to 8 years old



Stage Four: Seat Belt

- Over 36 kg (80 lb.)
- Approximately 8 to 12 years old

NOTE: Placement of car seats should always be in the back seat of the vehicle
